**Additional Ship Creek King Salmon Requirements:**

1. Limited to one King Salmon larger than 20" per day
2. After keeping a King Salmon 20" or larger, harvest must be immediately recorded
3. After taking a King Salmon 20" or larger, that person may not fish for any species of fish open to the taking of King Salmon that same day
4. Ship Creek is open for King Salmon fishing only between 6am and 11pm
