Who can be a volunteer at the Slam'n Salm'n Festival?

Anyone who wants to connect with and contribute to their community, and doesn't mind chilling outside with muddy fishermen! We guarantee there is something to keep you busy - no matter your age.

What does a volunteer do?

That depends on what you feel up to! Feel like lifting and weighing fish? Well, there are definitely plenty of fish to be weighed. Would rather relax and rep the Downtown Hope Center? The DHC needs it and appreciates it! There are plenty of activities - ticket and merchandise sales, photography, clean-up, grilling, managing the kids' table, etc - to make sure everyone has something to do.

Where do we volunteer? Where do I park?

Look for the log cabin directly across from the ULU factory on W Ship Creek Ave, just north of 1st Ave. If you're not sure where to park, stop in at the log cabin and a shift leader will direct you to the parking lot. We have a limited number of free parking passes for our volunteers, so if you're arriving with a group, carpool is recommended.

What should I wear? Do I need to bring anything?

We recommend dressing comfortably and in layers. The entire event is outdoors so you'll want to be prepared if the weather turns. Unless you're weighing fish, you don't need to worry about getting muddy. As for food, the shift leader will grill hot dogs and hamburgers for lunch each day. If you have dietary restrictions, you may prefer to bring your own meals. Food trucks and Feed Me Hope Bakery will be selling goods nearby, if you prefer to purchase your food at the festival.

Do I have to know anything about fish or fishing?

Nope - the fishermen know what they're doing! We'll have the Slam'n Salm'n Festival guidelines and the Dept of Fish and Game guidelines posted on location. As long as all the participants are abiding by the rules, we're golden! Your shift manager can answer any questions about fishing policies you don't know the answer to.

When does the festival start and what hours should I volunteer?

The Slam'n Salm'n Festival begins June 9th at 8am and ends June 16th at 12 pm, followed by a finale BBQ around 2 pm. Shifts run 3.25 hours long, but you're welcome to stay longer. You can sign up for as many shifts as you would like.
